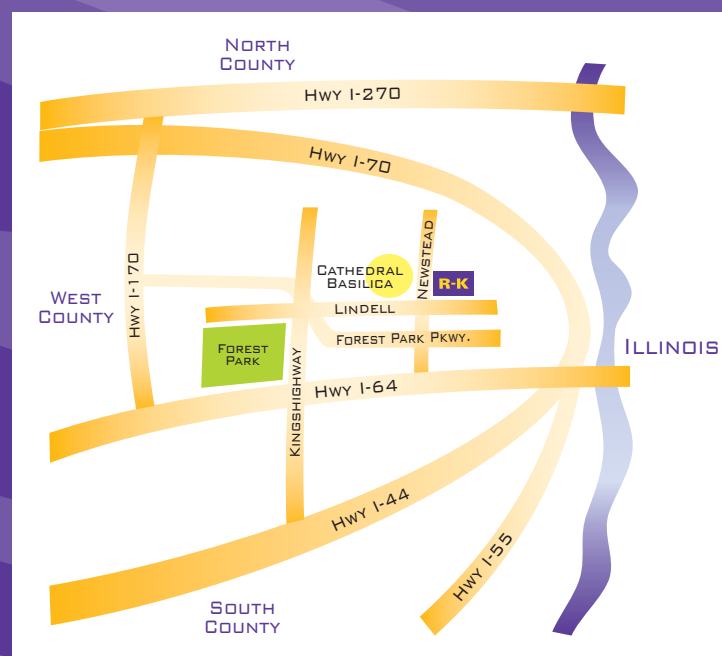

WHY AREN'T THERE BOYS?

Rosati-Kain began as an all-girls school nearly 100 years ago and proudly continues in that tradition. Today, R-K readily embraces the opportunities – and addresses the challenges – presented by a single-sex school.

As a student, your time is focused on your academic and extra-curricular choices, which are essential to helping you become a young woman ready to face an ever-changing world community.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A CATHOLIC SCHOOL?

As a Catholic, Archdiocesan high school, R-K believes that students become their best selves through learning about and living in their faith. Monthly liturgies, days of reconciliation, and retreats are just a few of the spiritual activities that help students deepen their faith.

We also place an emphasis on peer ministry, meaning that students guide each other in faith. Working with R-K's campus minister, upperclassmen lead the underclassmen at prayer days and retreats. This helps all students grow in faith together in a supportive environment.

DO I HAVE TO BE CATHOLIC TO ATTEND ROSATI-KAIN?

Students of all faiths are invited to attend R-K. All students take Catholic theology classes and attend prayer activities, regardless of their religious affiliation.

WHO WILL BE TEACHING MY DAUGHTER?

The young women at R-K have a dedicated faculty and staff of religious women and lay women and men. The majority of the faculty has advanced degrees.

HOW MUCH DOES ROSATI-KAIN COST?

Rosati-Kain has the lowest tuition of any all-girl Catholic high school in the St. Louis metropolitan area. All textbooks, retreat costs and technology fees are included in the base tuition.

Our tuition is about \$1,500 lower than what it actually costs to educate each R-K student. We are able to keep our tuition affordable due to financial support from the Alumnae Association, our Annual Fund appeal, parent fundraisers and the Archdiocesan Annual Catholic Appeal. WHERE DO MOST ROSATI-KAIN STUDENTS LIVE?

R-K is one of the most geographically diverse high schools in St. Louis. R-K girls come from throughout the metropolitan area, including over 60 zip codes, about 90 parishes, and over 100 grade schools. R-K students live in North, South and West St. Louis County, St. Louis city, St. Charles County, Jefferson County, Franklin County and several counties in Illinois. Students mostly travel to school via carpool.

HOW WILL ROSATI-KAIN PREPARE MY DAUGHTER FOR COLLEGE?

R-K is accredited as a college preparatory school by AdvancED. Our curriculum is designed to make students successful in college. A student who has completed the requirements to graduate from R-K will meet the requirements for admission into almost any college program. At R-K, we have a 100% college acceptance rate, with over 99% attending college, and about 70% of R-K graduates have received academic scholarships to college.

ADMISSIONS

Rosati-Kain High School is the Catholic high school today, for the woman you will become tomorrow. As a college preparatory high school, Rosati-Kain is the place for young women who value academic success, with an emphasis on the individual student. At R-K, each student can find a place where she truly belongs.

The criteria for admission are based on the 6th, 7th, and 8th grade years:

- A/B average
- Standardized testing scores in the 70th percentile or above (top 30%)
- Good conduct and attendance record
