### ARCHBISHOP-ELECT, MOST REV. ROBERT J. CARLSON VISITS ROSATI-KAIN Visit followed announcement of new St. Louis Archbishop

St. Louis – On April 21, 2009, the Holy See appointed the Most Rev. Robert J. Carlson as the successor to Archbishop Raymond L. Burke as the Archbishop of Saint Louis, Missouri.

Upon arriving in St. Louis, Archbishop-elect visited Rosati-Kain and met with students. After presenting him with some R-K memorabilia, the students sang the new school song, which has been written in honor of the school's Centennial Year in 2012.

The Archbishop presented Rosati-Kain with a special crucifix as a gift, which will be displayed prominently at the school.

Prior to his appointment to the Archdiocese of Saint Louis, Bishop Robert J. Carlson had served as the fifth bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Saginaw for the past four years. He was later ordained as an auxiliary bishop for his home archdiocese and went on to serve as Bishop of Sioux Falls, S.D., from 1994 to 2005.
