ROSATI-KAIN'S NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY HOSTS ANNUAL SPRING BLOOD DRIVE Rosati-Kain donates 59 units of blood, equivalent to saving 177 lives

St. Louis – Rosati-Kain High School's National Honor Society hosted its annual blood drive on Tuesday, March 31. The Mississippi Valley Regional Blood Center was on site to collect the units of blood. Contributors donated 59 units of blood, exceeding the goal of 56 units.

"Donating blood is crucial. For every unit donated, three lives are saved. Our efforts today have given 177 St. Louis residents the chance for life," said NHS vice-president Julie Quinn, Head of Blood Drive.

The Mississippi Valley Regional Blood Center acknowledged the success of the drive by giving \$300 to Rosati-Kain through its Life Savings Grant. The program awards \$250 for a minimum of 20 units and gives an additional \$50 for 50 units. Rosati-Kain will donate \$250 of the Life Savings Grant to the Marsha Korte Scholarship Fund, which was created in memory of the beloved business teacher, who passed away in December.
