- ✓ The class of 1955 has the highest participation rate at 35 donors and has pledged a total of \$104,945.00 for the campaign.
- ✓ The class of 1963 has 22 donors so far and has pledged \$147,650.00.
- ✓ The class of 1975 has 4 donors so far and has pledged \$56,925.00.
- ✓ 71% of the pledges have come from R-K alumnae.

TUITION ASSISTANCE GRANT

In November, R-K received a \$31,000 tuition assistance grant from the Vassia Family Charitable Foundation.

This gift allowed R-K to give one-time grants to students and their families who might not have been otherwise able to afford tuition this year.
