### **ROSATI-KAIN TEACHER DONNA SCOTT TO RECEIVE TEACHER RECOGNITION AWARD FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE OF ST. LOUIS Award distinguishes outstanding service and performance**

St. Louis – The Archdiocese of St. Louis has chosen Rosati-Kain teacher, Donna Scott, to receive the Archbishop Raymond L. Burke Teacher Recognition Award. She was chosen by a group of secondary principals, and is the only secondary school teacher to receive this award.

A teacher must also give evidence of using several of the methods and techniques that would be currently characterized as "best practice" in education.
