Tuition does not cover the complete cost to educate a student. Based on our best projections, our profile follows.

Estimated cost to educate a student at Rosati-Kain in 2011-12: \$9500

- *Archdiocesan support through parishes* \$300
- *Archdiocesan Development Appeal* \$327
- *Per Student proceeds from All-School Fund -raising* \$176
- *Per Student proceeds from the ANNUAL FUND DRIVE* \$523
- *Per Student proceeds from miscellaneous gifts and fees* \$74

You and other generous donors generate this auxiliary support in order to keep tuition lower than the cost to educate!

Tuition for students from Catholic parishes/schools: \$7900
Tuition for students not from Catholic parishes/schools: \$8400

(Non-Catholic students pay higher tuition to complement parish and archdiocesan stipend)

An additional \$200 registration fee is paid February of the preceding year; this amount is applied toward tuition. A \$200 graduation fee is required for all seniors.

Fees for books, technology, retreats, and lab courses are included in tuition.

The enclosed materials pertain to payment options. EACH FAMILY must choose one of these plans. If you are choosing an annual or semester plan, payments must be received on or before due dates. If you choose a monthly or quarterly plan, you MUST REGISTER ON LINE. There is no automatic reenrollment of returning families. This is different than previous years. Scholarship awards, grant-in-aid and other reductions will be applied as Rosati-Kain receives notification.
